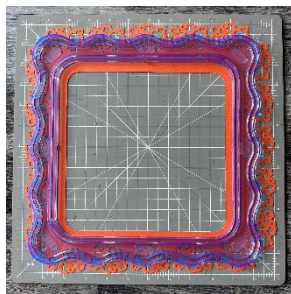
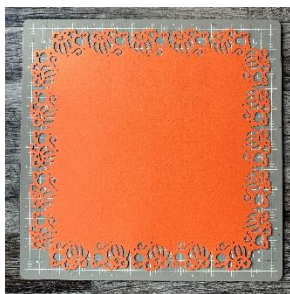
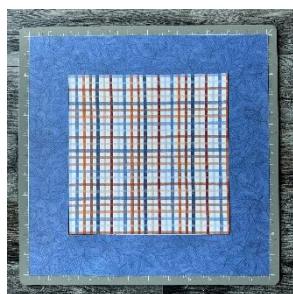

Tools / Supplies: (1) Double-sided Print, (2) Sheets of Coordinating Cardstock, Frame Border Punch or Jumbo Wavy Square CCS

Collection Shown: Autumn Harvest Prints, Pumpkin, Blue, Beige, Hot Fudge Cardstock, Pumpkin Patch Frame Border Punch, Jumbo Wavy Square CCS



Cut a 2" frame from the base print (cuts out an 8" square).

Use a Frame Border Punch on a sheet of cardstock. Cut out the center using the 12" Trimmer or inside of the Jumbo Wavy Square.

Cut a 9" square from another sheet of cardstock. Cut out a 7" square from the middle (1" frame").

Layer the 8" square onto the 9" frame onto the punched frame onto the base print frame.

The 7" square can be cut into a 5x7" photo mat and 2x7" title bar or use other mats as applicable to your photos.

Variation: Use the Jumbo Wavy Square CCS w/ Red Blade on the 12" cardstock instead of a frame border punch. Cut out the inside for use on another project. Adhere the outside wavy 'scrap' to another print for a 2nd layout.



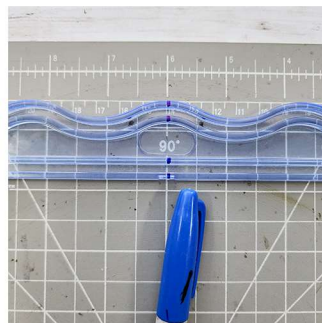
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Supplies

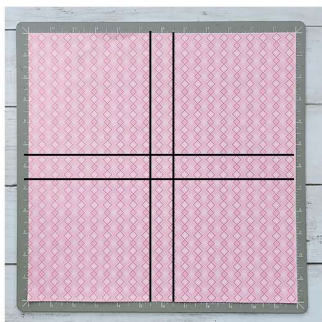
- 1 Sheet Tonal Designer Paper or Cardstock for Base
- 1 Sheet of Designer Paper
- 2 Border Elements
- Wavy Frame Jumbo CCS Pattern
- Cardstock for Mats

TIPS: Practice with scrap paper to get used to cutting the Wavy Frame. Make sure your blades are nice and sharp to get the best cut. Use repo adhesive to adhere paper to cutting mat.



MARKING FOR CENTER ON THE WAVY FRAME JUMBO CCS

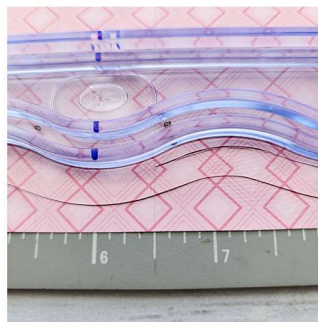
1. Mark the manufacturing dot in the outer track on each corner.
2. Line up the dots with the 45-degree lines on the 13 x 13 cutting mat.
3. Mark each side of the template at the 6" line.



1. With a pencil, lightly draw lines at 5-1/2\"/>



2. Center the Wavy Frame on the paper and cut with the blue blade on the outside track. Do not lift template.



3. Use the RED blade on the outside track to cut from pencil line to pencil line in each corner.



4. Fold back each corner so the peak of the wave meets the pencil line. After folding, erase pencil line and then adhere flaps.



5. Adhere cut piece to background page.
6. Add border details to center as desired.
7. Trim four 4\"/>
